Dear Members of the Committee of Bar Examiners:

Rule 4.245 of the Unaccredited Law School Rules require unaccredited law schools to obtain permission for major changes. Major changes is defined in Rule 4.246 and includes in "(l) changing the ownership of the school."

Earlier this year, we notified the Office of Admissions that the Washington Post Company, which owns Kaplan, Inc. which in turn owns Kaplan University, had sold the Washington Post Newspaper and the Washington Post Company would be changing its name. This is a courtesy notice to advise the Committee that the Washington Post Company changed its name to Graham Holdings Company effective November 29, 2013. There is no change in ownership but simply a change in the name of the company.
