SUBJECT: Notices of Changes in Law School Administrators

Pursuant to Guideline 4.11(A) of the *Guidelines for Unaccredited Law School Rules*, the following registered, unaccredited law schools seek to notify the Committee of Bar Examiners (Committee) of the following changes in administrative personnel:

Oak Brook College of Law

The law school provided notice that its long-serving Dean, Roger Magnuson, passed away in November, 2013. To replace him, Mr. J. Douglas McElvy has been appointed Dean. Mr. McElvy is a licensed member of the Alabama Bar and is therefore qualified to act as the law school's dean. The law school is a registered, unaccredited correspondence law school that, as required by the *Guidelines for Unaccredited Law School Rules*, maintains its principal administrative office in Fresno and has a qualified, part-time administrator in the person of Mr. Peter Fear, a licensed member of the California State Bar who practices in Fresno.

Abraham Lincoln University School of Law

The law school provided notice that Dean Carole J. Buckner has resigned her position, effective February 13, 2014. The law school is a registered, unaccredited distance-learning law school that maintains its principal administrative offices in Los Angeles. The owner of the law school, Mr. Hyung Park, has appointed himself to act as Dean. Dean Park is a licensed member of the State Bar of California and is therefore qualified to act as Dean.
