


## Unaccredited, Fixed-Facility Law Schools Faculty/Student Comparison Reporting Enrolled Students


# Breakdown of Student Ethnicity for Unaccredited, Fixed-Facility Law Schools



Average = 48.4% Female / 51.6% Male**





## Enrollment in Unaccredited, Correspondence Law Schools Average = 140






## Unaccredited, Correspondence Law Schools Faculty/Student Comparison

# Breakdown of Student Ethnicity for Unaccredited, Correspondence Law Schools




# Gender Comparison of Enrolled Students for Unaccredited, Correspondence Law Schools



## Enrollment in Unaccredited, Distance-Learning Law Schools Average = 194






## Unaccredited, Distance-Learning Law Schools Faculty/Student Comparison

## Breakdown of Student Ethnicity for Unaccredited, Distance-Learning Law Schools


