

**NOTICE OF NONCOMPLIANCE**  
**To**  
**Pacific West College of Law**  
**A fixed-facility, Unaccredited Registered Law School**

**Pursuant to Rule 4.260 of the *Unaccredited Law School Rules*, and based upon the periodic inspection of the law school conducted March 29-30, 20126, the Committee of Bar Examiners has cause to believe that the Pacific West College of Law (PWCOL), a registered, unaccredited, fixed-facility law school, is not in compliance with one or more of *Guidelines for Unaccredited Law School Rules (Guidelines)* and hereby issues the law school this Notice of Noncompliance.**

The finding of noncompliance confirmed during the periodic inspection of PWCOL relates to each of the following Guidelines:

- 1) Guidelines 2.3 (A), (B), (C) and (F) (Honesty in Communications);
- 2) Guideline 2.9 (C) (Fairness in Academic Standards and Student Assessment);
- 3) Guideline 3.2 (Duties of Governing Board);
- 4) Guidelines 4.1 (Law School Administrator, Duties) and 4.2 (Law School Dean and Faculty, Duties);
- 5) Guideline 4.3 (Faculty Participation in Academic Policies and Programs);
- 6) Guidelines 4.8 (Evaluation of Instructors) and 4.9 (Basis of Instructor Evaluations);
- 7) Guidelines 5.1 Academic Program); 5.2 (Criteria for Determining Compliance with Guideline 5.1); 5.7 (Evaluation of Student Credentials); 5.9 (Quantitative Academic Requirements); 5.17 (Grading Standards); 5.18 (Scholastic Standards); and 5.25 (Criteria for Evaluating Quality of Examinations);
- 8) Guidelines 2.2 (Honesty Regarding Finances) and 8.3 (Financial Reports);
- 9) Guideline 9.1 subsections (B) (Records of Admission), (C) (Student Files) and (D) (Transcripts);
- 10) Guideline 9.1 (G) (Administrative Personnel);
- 11) Guideline 9.1 (H) (Faculty Personnel); .
- 12) Guideline 9.1 (O)(1) (Annual Compliance Report).

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**Pursuant to Rule 4.261, within fifteen (15) days of the receipt by Pacific West College of Law of this Notice, it must file a response as to its compliance or is taking steps to achieve compliance with each of the findings of its noncompliance as described above. In further compliance with Rule 2.61, the response must be submitted with the fee of \$924.00 as set forth in the Unaccredited Law School Fees.**
