

**NOTICE OF NONCOMPLIANCE  
TO

Pursuant to Rule 4.260 of the *Unaccredited Law School Rules* (Rules), the Committee of Bar Examiners (Committee) has found grounds to believe that the University of Silicon Valley School of Law (USVSOL), a registered, unaccredited, fixed-facility law school, is not in compliance with the certain Rules and specific Guidelines of the *Guidelines for Unaccredited Law School Rules* (Guidelines) and hereby issues USVSOL this Notice of Noncompliance.

The noncompliance of USVSOL relates to the following:

*Unaccredited Law School Rules*

1. Rule 4.244 (Inspections)  
Failure to facilitate the inspection of the law school in a timely manner.

*Guidelines for Unaccredited Law School Rules:*

1. Guideline 4.1 (Law School Administrator, Duties)  
Failure to maintain an administrator able to devote adequate time to the administration of the law school to maintain its compliant operation.
2. Guideline 5.1 (Academic Program)  
Failure to maintain a qualitatively and quantitatively sound program of legal education.
3. Guideline 5.2(K) (Cumulative Success of Graduates on the California Bar Exam)  
Failure to provide students and graduates a reasonable opportunity to pass the First-Year Law Students' Examination and the California Bar Examination.
4. Guideline 6.2 (Library Requirements)  
Failure to maintain and update a compliant hardcopy law library.
5. Guideline 9.1 (Record Keeping)  
Failure to create and maintain complaint student transcripts and student files.

Pursuant to Rule 4.261, within fifteen (15) days of the receipt by USVSOL of this Notice, if the school intends to contest this Notice, it must file its response to each of the Rules and Guidelines cited above and submit a fee of \$924.00 as set forth in the *Unaccredited Law School Fees*.
