Re: Request for Approval of Administrative Office Move

Dear Mr. Leal:

In accordance with Rule 4.245 of the Unaccredited Law School Rules which requires the College to notify the Committee and obtain its prior approval before making a major change, Oak Brook College of Law is seeking approval from the Committee of Bar Examiners for changing the location of the law school's administrative office. We anticipate the proposed move of the administrative office to occur in mid to late December of 2016. The move is precipitated by the relocation of the law office of Peter Fear, the Director of Administration of Oak Brook College of Law. The law office move is expected to take place in November 2016.

The relocation of the College administrative office will allow for continued beneficial proximity of the College administrative office to Peter Fear's law office, permitting Mr. Fear's continued direct oversight of the day to day operation of the College. Additionally the move will result in monthly cost savings for the College.

As a correspondence program, the College utilizes our website to provide study materials to our students, for assignment submissions, and feedback on the assignments. The website resides on a server outside of the administrative office and as a result, instruction through our website will continue without any interruption in instruction caused by the office move. The office relocation will have no negative impact on the College's students or with its compliance with the Unaccredited Law School.

The new office space is approximately 450 square feet in size which is about half the current office space. As a correspondence program, Oak Brook College of Law has the benefit of being able to operate with minimal physical space requirements. The new office space is sufficient for our needs and will include its own outside entrance, a monitored security system, and a secure computer server room.

Enclosed is a map showing the current office location at 7750 N. Fresno Street, Suite 104, Fresno, CA 93720, and the proposed location at 7650 N. Palm Avenue, Suite 101B, Fresno, CA 93711), as well as a basic office floor plan of the new location. The College phone and fax numbers will not change.


If any additional information is required, please do not hesitate to contact me. Oak Brook College of Law looks forward to receiving the notice of approval of our administrative office move.



 OFFICE - SUITE 101


