


1 5. On page 8 of the Stipulation, the alleged violation in Count Three of the Notice of
2 Disciplinary Charges is changed to read "6068(k)" instead of "6069(k)."

4 Finally, in light of the joint motion of the parties pursuant to rule 262(e) of the Rules of
5 Procedure, the Court **HEREBY DISMISSES** Counts One and Three of the Notice of Disciplinary
6 Charges in the above-entitled proceeding **WITH PREJUDICE**.


