) **ORDER GRANTING RESPONDENT'S**
) **REQUEST FOR MODIFICATION OF A**
) **PROBATION CONDITION**

On October 18, 2002, respondent Geoffrey Ojo and the State Bar submitted a Stipulation as to Facts and Disposition in the underlying disciplinary proceedings. The stipulation was approved and filed by the State Bar Court on October 23, 2002. Thereafter, by minute order filed March 18, 2003, in case No. S112447, the Supreme Court adopted this court's recommended disposition which included that respondent obtain psychiatric or psychological help/treatment from a duly licenced psychiatrist at respondent's expense for a minimum of once a week.

By motion filed on February 2, 2006, petitioner GEOFFREY OJO has moved this court pursuant to rule 550 of the Rules of Procedure of the State Bar of California for an order modifying the above mental health condition. Respondent's request is based on the ground that respondent's condition has substantially improved and a treatment plan of one office visit per week is not required, as reported by respondent's psychiatrist, Dr. Soroya Bacchus.

The State Bar of California, Office of Probation, does not oppose respondent's motion.

In light of the foregoing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that respondent's Motion for Modification of a Probation Condition is **GRANTED**. Respondent must undergo psychotherapy with a licensed psychiatrist at



respondent's expense for a minimum of once a month and must provide to the Office of Probation satisfactory proof of his compliance in his quarterly report.

IT IS SO ORDERED.


