On January 4, 2006, the Order Approving Stipulation Re Facts, Conclusions of Law and Disposition was filed in the above-captioned matter. On February 22, 2006, the Office of the Chief Trial Counsel of the State Bar of California (State Bar) filed a motion to modify the stipulation to include six hours of MCLE that respondent is required to complete. However, the State Bar's motion to modify was not brought within the required 15 days after service of the court's order approving the stipulation. (Rules Proc. of State Bar, rule 135(b).)

By respondent's Notice received on February 24, 2006, respondent does not object to the State Bar's motion.

Accordingly, the court finding good cause, on its own motion, hereby modifies the Order Approving Stipulation in this matter, by inserting on page 9, paragraph b, "six" in the blank space immediately prior to the words "hours of Minimum Continuing Legal Education."

Any objection to this modification order must be filed within 15 days of its service. If no

timely objection is filed, the stipulation as modified remains approved, and it is ordered that this matter be transmitted to the Supreme Court without further delay.
