Since respondent **BRADLEY DEAN BAYAN**, State Bar number 218751, has been convicted of violating Penal Code section 422, a felony for which there is probable cause to believe that it involves moral turpitude, under the authority of rule 951(a) of the California Rules of Court, it is ordered pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 6102 that respondent be suspended from the practice of law, effective August 11, 2005, pending final disposition of this proceeding.¹ It is further ordered that respondent comply with rule 955 of the California Rules of Court and perform the acts specified in paragraphs (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 days, respectively, after the effective date of this suspension.

¹Respondent was also convicted of violating Penal Code section 166, subdivision (a)(4) and Penal Code section 653m, subdivision (a), misdemeanors which may or may not involve moral turpitude.


