On March 11, 2010, Respondent Ruben D. Sanchez (Respondent) filed a request for an extension of time during which he may present proof of passage of the MPRE. The time for him to present such proof is currently scheduled to expire in April 2010. His motion also requested that the term of his probation be "extended" to November 30, 2011.

On March 18, 2010, the State Bar filed a statement of non-opposition to the request that the time for presenting proof of passage of the MPRE be extended. The State Bar noted, however, that Respondent's probation already extends beyond the November 30, 2011 date, so there is no need for it to be extended.
