

Since respondent **STEPHEN YAGMAN, State Bar number 69737**, has been convicted of violating title 18 United States Code sections 1957 and 2, a felony involving moral turpitude, title 26 United States Code section 7201 and title 18 United States Code section 2, a felony for which there is probable cause to believe that it involves moral turpitude, and title 18 United States Code sections 157 and 2, a felony, under the authority of rule 9.10(a) of the California Rules of Court, it is ordered pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 6102 that respondent be suspended from the practice of law, effective August 23, 2007, pending final disposition of this proceeding. The review department reserves the moral turpitude classification of title 18 United States Code sections 157 and 2. It is further ordered that respondent comply with rule 9.20 of the California Rules of Court and perform the acts specified in paragraphs (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 days, respectively, after the effective date of this suspension.


