On April 12, 2011, respondent **RUTH CECILIA ROSE** filed a brief seeking relief from or extension of time to pay disciplinary costs in the above captioned matter. Respondent's motion was based on financial hardship. On May 3, 2011, Deputy Trial Counsel Larry DeSha of the Office of the Chief Trial Counsel of the State Bar of California ("State Bar") filed its response in non-opposition. The court held a telephonic status conference with the parties on May 16, 2011.

After careful consideration of respondent's motion and the State Bar's non-opposition, the court GRANTS the motion, good cause having been shown. The court orders that respondent's time to pay the disciplinary costs associated with Supreme Court Case No. S149813 be extended and that commencing February 10, 2012, and continuing on the 10th of each following month, respondent must pay \$152.54 in disciplinary costs, payments to end on March 10, 2013. The court further ORDERS that, if respondent fails to pay any installment of disciplinary costs within the time provided herein or as may be modified by the State Bar Court

pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 6086.10, subdivision (c), the remaining balance of the costs is due and payable immediately unless relief has been granted under the Rules of Procedure of the State Bar of California (Rules Proc. of State Bar, rule 5.130(B)). The payment of costs remains enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.

IT IS SO ORDERED.


