On January 14, 2013, Respondent filed a request for an extension of time during which he may present proof of passage of the MPRE. On January 15, 2013, the Office of Probation filed an opposition to that request.

On January 16, 2013, this court issued an order requiring Respondent to provide additional evidence regarding his request and scheduling a hearing on the matter on January 31, 2013.


On January 22, 2013, Respondent provided the requested additional information. On January 31, 2013, the scheduled hearing was conducted.

GOOD CAUSE APPEARING and pursuant to rule 9.10(b) of the California Rules of Court, the court GRANTS Respondent's motion to extend the time during which he may present proof of passage of the April 6, 2013 MPRE. Accordingly, the time in which Respondent may and must present proof to the Office of Probation of his passage of the MPRE is extended until ten (10) calendar days after the results of the April 6, 2013 MPRE are released.

Except as expressly stated above, the motion is otherwise DENIED.


