Introduction

This matter is before the court on petitioner Lawrence W. Taggart's February 26, 2010, petition for reconsideration of installment payment plan. The State Bar of California ("State Bar") filed a response in non-opposition on March 2, 2010. Respondent is representing himself in this matter. The State Bar is represented by Deputy Trial Counsel Margaret Warren.

After a careful review of the respondent's petition and the response, the court GRANTS the petition, good cause having been shown. Accordingly, effective April 15, 2010 and continuing on the 15th of every following month, respondent will pay \$250.00 to the State Bar until his obligation is fully satisfied. In the event that petitioner either fails to make any installment payment or submits any installment payment more than ten (10) days after the due date without prior written approval of the State Bar's Office of Probation, the unpaid balance of the discipline costs shall become immediately due and owing to the State Bar, without further notice and without the approval of the State Bar Court. The State Bar may obtain and seek to collect a judgment for that unpaid balance.

Petitioner is ordered to submit his payments to the State Bar's Membership Billing Office and provide proof of each payment to the State Bar's Office of Probation.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
