**TO ALL PARTIES AND COUNSEL IN THE ABOVE ENTITLED MATTER:**

On April 28, 2011, petitioner **Deborah Ann Duggan** sought to extend time to pay disciplinary costs based on financial hardship. Petitioner proposed a monthly installment payment of \$100 until the costs are paid in full.

On May 3, 2011, Deputy Trial Counsel Mark Hartman of the Office of the Chief Trial Counsel of the State Bar of California filed a response and did not oppose petitioner's proposed payment plan in case Nos. 06-PM-13163 and 07-Q-13039.

In view of petitioner's financial hardship and for good cause appearing, petitioner's request to extend the time to pay the disciplinary costs is **GRANTED**. **Petitioner must pay \$100, due on the 1<sup>st</sup> of each month, beginning on June 1, 2011, and continuing until the disciplinary costs are paid in full in the above entitled cases.** If petitioner fails to timely make



any installment payment, or as may be modified by the State Bar Court, the unpaid balance is due and payable immediately. (Bus. & Prof. Code, §§ 6086.10, subd. (c), 6140.7; Rules Proc. of State Bar, rule 5.134.)


