On July 9, 2012, respondent Lisa R. Alexholland filed a motion to extend the time to attend State Bar Ethics School and to complete restitution, conditions ordered by the California Supreme Court in its order no. S190906. On July 17, 2012, the Office of Probation, by Terrie Goldade, filed opposition thereto, to which respondent replied on July 24, 2012.

Having considered the parties' contentions and good cause appearing, the motion is GRANTED as to extending the time to complete Ethics School and submit satisfactory proof of its completion no later than December 31, 2012.

The motion is DENIED WITHOUT PREJUDICE as to restitution as insufficient information, such as a financial declaration, has been provided to the court to assess the request.¹

¹ The court notes from the parties' filings that there seem to be some dispute as to the amount of restitution that has been made so far. It is expected that that parties will resolve these issues prior to the filing of another motion, if any, to seek such relief.

All other terms and conditions regarding S190906 remain the same.


