

GOOD CAUSE APPEARING THEREFOR, Sienski's unopposed motion for technical modification to probation is **GRANTED**. The probation condition requiring respondent to offer and participate in fee arbitration with Eric Van Alstine is modified to provide that in the event Eric Van Alstine rejects fee arbitration and elects to seek recovery of his attorney's fees in Van Alstine v. Prudential California Realty, et al., Orange County Superior Court Case No. 30-2008 00226215, Sienski will provide to the Office of Probation a copy of the settlement agreement and proof he satisfied the settlement. If he does so, Sienski will have satisfied the fee arbitration requirement of his probation.

This modification is minor and does not materially change the conditions of his probation.


