ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO MODIFY STIPULATION

Introduction

This matter is before the court on the State Bar's April 6, 2010, motion to modify stipulation. Respondent does not oppose the motion. The State Bar is represented by Deputy Trial Counsel Mia Ellis.

After a careful review, the court GRANTS the motion, good cause having been shown.

Accordingly, the stipulation in the above captioned matter is modified as set forth below:

Page 4 – Section D (3) (iii) – Delete the box check and the following language:

"completes 12 weeks of Anger Management Classes."

Page 6 – Section F (5) – Check box and add the following language:

"Respondent must successfully complete 12 hours of anger management classes within the first year of probation."

Page 13 – Delete the following handwritten language:

"Page 4 – D. (30 (iii) – insert after words "classes" consisting of an

hour session each week."



The parties have 15 days after the service of this order to file an objection to the modification.
