On June 28, 2011, respondent Sterling C. Johnson, by counsel Samuel C. Bellicini, filed a motion seeking an extension of time to successfully complete the Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination. Due to his own error and to the press of business, he did not complete the MPRE and provide proof thereof to the Office of Probation within one year of the effective date of the private reproval imposed effective June 29, 2010. On July 1, 2011, the Office of Probation, by Terrie D. Goldade, filed a response indicating no opposition to an extension to provide proof of the MPRE to one week after the release of the results of the August 5, 2011, MPRE.

Having considered the parties' contentions and good cause appearing, the court GRANTS the motion. Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that the time in which respondent must successfully complete the MPRE is extended until the results of the August 2011 MPRE are released.

Respondent must provide satisfactory proof of the successful completion of the MPRE to the



Office of Probation no later than 10 days after the results of the MPRE are received or August 19, 2011, whichever is later.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
