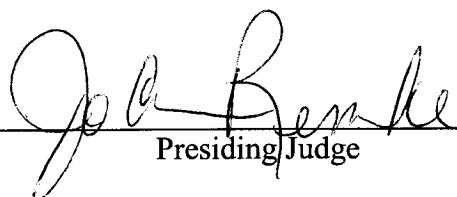

The Supreme Court in the above-entitled proceeding entered an Order filed January 28, 2011 requiring the respondent to take and pass the Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination within one year of the effective date of the Supreme Court order.
