TO ALL PARTIES AND COUNSEL IN THE ABOVE ENTITLED MATTER:

On January 11, 2012, this court filed an order approving and recommending to the California Supreme Court a stipulated discipline submitted by the parties to this court on December 29, 2012. Included within that recommended discipline was the standard MPRE requirement, stating that: "Respondent must provide proof of passage of the Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination ("MPRE") ... during the period of actual suspension or within one year, whichever period is longer."

While the stipulated discipline was pending with the Supreme Court, but before Respondent's actual suspension became effective, Respondent apparently took and passed the MPRE. The parties have now filed a stipulation to have the terms of his discipline be modified to make clear that his submitting proof of his passage of the MPRE since the stipulation was approved by this court in January 2012 will satisfy the above MPRE obligation.

GOOD CAUSE APPEARING, it is so ordered.
