ORDER RE DISCIPLINARY COSTS

TO ALL PARTIES AND COUNSEL IN THE ABOVE ENTITLED MATTER:

On September 9, 2013, petitioner **Michael Wayne Champ** filed an application for a waiver and/or reduction of disciplinary costs based on financial hardship.

On September 25, 2013, Senior Trial Counsel Erin McKeown Joyce of the Office of the Chief Trial Counsel of the State Bar of California (State Bar) opposed such a waiver and/or reduction of disciplinary costs, but recommended that an installment payment plan be imposed.


In view of petitioner's financial hardship, the court hereby **ORDERS** that petitioner's time during which to pay the disciplinary costs in S210920 be extended and that one-fifth of the costs must be paid with his membership fees for each of the years 2015, 2016, 2017, 2018, and 2019. If Michael Wayne Champ fails to pay any installment as described above, or as may be modified by the State Bar Court, the remaining balance is due and payable immediately. The



payment of costs remains enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.


