This matter is before the court on the motion to modify terms of reproof that respondent John Joseph Vandervoort (Respondent) filed on May 11, 2017.<sup>1</sup> (Rules Proc. of State Bar, rule 5.128.) The State Bar's Office of Probation does not oppose Respondent's motion.

In light of Respondent's health issues as detailed in his motion, its attachments, and his declaration filed May 15, 2017, the court finds good cause to modify the conditions attached to the public reproof that was imposed on Respondent in the court's decision and discipline order and order sealing certain documents filed on June 14, 2016, to extend the time in which Respondent must take and successfully complete the State Bar's Ethics School and must take and pass the Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination. The court further finds that these modifications are consistent with public protection, Respondent's rehabilitation, and maintaining the profession's integrity. Accordingly, the court will grant Respondent's motion.




**ORDER**

The court orders that Respondent's May 11, 2017, motion to modify terms of reproof is GRANTED and that the conditions attached to the public reproof that was imposed on Respondent in the court's June 14, 2016, decision and discipline order and order sealing certain documents are MODIFIED as follows:

1. the time in which Respondent must provide the Office of Probation with satisfactory proof of attendance at a session of the State Bar Ethics School and passage of the test given at the end of that session is EXTENDED until August 11, 2017; and
2. the time in which Respondent must take and pass the Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination and provide satisfactory proof of such passage to the State Bar's Office of Probation in Los Angeles is EXTENDED until September 27, 2017.
