On March 13, 2015, Respondent Terrence John Hardin filed a motion for extension of time to provide proof of passage of the Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination (MPRE). On March 17, 2015, the Office of Probation of the State Bar filed an opposition to Respondent's motion.

Finding no good cause and for failure to address the factors identified by Rules of Procedure of the State Bar, rule 5.162(E)(2), (3) and (4), Respondent's motion is denied without prejudice to the filing of another motion that addresses the relevant factors. Respondent is suspended from the practice of law in this state effective May 4, 2015, pending proof of passage of the MPRE, for failure to pass the MPRE within the time prescribed by the Supreme Court order filed on February 6, 2014.


