On March 27, 2018, respondent Michael Christopher Bennett filed a motion for extension of time to pay disciplinary costs of \$21,390.12, based on financial hardship. He proposed an installment payment of \$356.62 a month for the next five years until the costs are paid in full.

On May 3, 2018, Supervising Attorney Allen Blumenthal of the Office of Chief Trial Counsel of the State Bar of California filed a non-opposition reply.

Based on respondent's financial hardship, the court hereby grants respondent's motion for an extension of time to pay disciplinary costs, in part, and **ORDERS** that respondent's time during which to pay the disciplinary costs be extended and **that one-third of the costs must be paid with his membership fees for each of the years 2019, 2020, and 2021.** If Michael Christopher Bennett fails to pay any installment as described above, or as may be modified by the State Bar Court, the remaining balance is due and payable immediately. The payment of costs remains enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.

IT IS SO ORDERED.


