On January 17, 2018, respondent filed a motion for an extension of time to pay disciplinary costs in State Bar case No. 13-O-14606. (Rules Proc. of State Bar, rule 5.130.)

Respondent's motion was based on financial hardship. (See Rules Proc. of State Bar, rule 5.130(B).) On January 18, 2018, the Office of Chief Trial Counsel of the State Bar of California (State Bar) filed a response. In its response, the State Bar did not oppose an extension of time for the payment of costs.

Good cause having been shown, the court **GRANTS** an extension of time for respondent to comply with the order to pay disciplinary costs. The court orders that respondent's time to pay the remaining disciplinary costs associated with case No. 13-O-14606 be extended and that one-fourth of said costs is to be paid with respondent's annual State Bar membership fees for the years 2019, 2020, 2021, and 2022.

The court further orders that if respondent fails to pay any installment of disciplinary costs within the time provided herein or as may be modified by the State Bar Court pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 6086.10, subdivision (c), the remaining balance of the costs is due and payable immediately unless relief has been granted under rule 5.134 of the Rules

of Procedure of the State Bar. The payment of costs remains enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
