On May 23, 2017, respondent Frank Russell Wilson (Respondent) and the Office of Chief Trial Counsel of the State Bar of California filed a stipulation to modify the terms of Respondent's probation in the above-listed matter (stipulation for modification). The stipulation for modification stated specific facts demonstrating that the requested relief is appropriate and serves the objectives of probation.

The court finds that the stipulation for modification is consistent with protecting the public, Respondent's successful rehabilitation, and maintaining the integrity of the legal profession. Good cause having been shown, the stipulation for modification is **APPROVED**, and Respondent's conditions of probation in the above-listed matter are modified as follows:

1. On pages 8 and 9 of the disciplinary stipulation, all references to "LAP case manager" are deleted, and in their place is inserted "LAP case manager/monitor"; and
2. On page 9 of the stipulation, numbered paragraph 10 is deleted in its entirety, and in its place the following paragraph is inserted:

Respondent shall submit to the Office of Probation an original, signed declaration as to whether or not he is in compliance with the LAP treatment conditions by each January 10, April 10, July 10, and October 10 covered by this

discipline. Additionally, Respondent shall request in writing that LAP send the Office of Probation a quarterly report regarding his compliance. Respondent understands that the declarations and reports may be shared with the Office of Chief Trial Counsel and the State Bar Court.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
