On June 14, 2017, petitioner Frank Russell Wilson sought an extension of time to comply with the order assessing disciplinary costs in State Bar Court case No. 14-C-03326. (Rules Proc. of State Bar, rule 5.130.) Petitioner's motion was based on financial hardship. (See Rules Proc. of State Bar, rule 5.130(B).) The Office of Chief Trial Counsel of the State Bar of California did not file a response.


Good cause having been shown, the court **GRANTS** an extension of time for Petitioner to comply with the order to pay disciplinary costs. The court orders that Petitioner's time to pay the disciplinary costs associated with case No. 14-C-03326 be extended and that one-third of said costs is to be paid with Petitioner's annual State Bar membership fees for the years 2018, 2019, and 2020. The court further **ORDERS** that if Petitioner fails to pay any installment of disciplinary costs within the time provided herein or as may be modified by the State Bar Court pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 6086.10, subdivision (c), the remaining balance of the costs is due and payable immediately unless relief has been granted under the Rules of Procedure of the State Bar of California (Rules Proc. of State Bar, rule 5.134). The



payment of costs remains enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.


