Regarding felony classification: 21 U.S.C. §§ 841(a)(1), (b)(1)(A) provides for imprisonment for not less than 10 years and 21 U.S.C. §§ 841(a)(1), (b)(1)(B) provides for imprisonment for not less than five years (note that p. 2 of plea agreement re guilt and p. 9 re sentencing discuss different portions of the section). Federal crimes punishable by more than one year imprisonment are felonies. (18 USCS, section 3559(a)(5).)

Regarding moral turpitude classification: see *In re Leardo* (1991) 53 Cal.3d 1, 10 [violation of 21 U.S.C. section 841(a)(1), in and of itself, involves moral turpitude] and *In re McAllister* (1939) 14 Cal.2d 602, 603 [conspiracy involves moral turpitude if target crime involves moral turpitude].

Violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 1956(a)(1)(A)(i), (B)(i), (B)(ii), and (h), Conspiracy to Launder Money, one count, a felony involving moral turpitude.

Regarding felony classification: 18 U.S.C. §§ 1956(a)(1)(A) provides for imprisonment of not more than 20 years. This is a felony pursuant to 18 USCS, section 3559(a)(3).

Regarding moral turpitude classification: see *U.S. v. Levine* (10th Cir. 1992) 970 F.2d 681, 686 [element of violation is to knowingly conceal], *Coppock v. State Bar* (1988) 44 Cal.3d 665, 679 [concealment is dishonest and involves moral turpitude], and *In re McAllister* (1939) 14 Cal.2d 602, 603 [conspiracy involves moral turpitude if target crime involves moral turpitude].
