By motion filed May 9, 2018, ADAM J. LUETTO (Respondent), sought a relief from, or an extension of time to pay disciplinary costs assessed in the above-captioned matters. (Rules Proc. Of State Bar, rule 5.130(B)) Respondent's motion was based on financial hardship. On June 5, 2018, the Office of Chief Trial Counsel of the State Bar of California (State Bar) filed a response opposing relief from, but not extension of time, for Respondent to pay the assessed disciplinary costs.


After reviewing the parties' pleadings, the court issues the following orders:

1. Respondent's motion for complete relief from payment of disciplinary costs is **DENIED**, no good cause having been shown; and
2. Respondent is **GRANTED** an extension of time to comply with the order to pay disciplinary costs in view of Respondent's current financial hardship. The court orders that Respondent's time to commence payment of disciplinary costs associated with the above-referenced cases be extended and shall be paid with Respondent's annual State Bar membership fees for the years 2019, 2020, 2021 and 2022.
3. The court further orders that, if Respondent fails to pay any installment of disciplinary costs within the time provided herein or as may be modified by the State Bar Court pursuant to Business and

Professions Code section 6086.10, subdivision (c), the remaining balance of the costs is due and payable immediately unless relief has been granted under the Rules Proc. Of State Bar, rule 5.134. The payment of costs remains enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.

**IT IS SO ORDERED.**


