On March 29, 2017, this court approved a Stipulation re Facts, Conclusions of Law, and Disposition, executed by the parties and submitted to the court. That stipulation included various conditions of probation.

The Supreme Court subsequently imposed the discipline stipulated to by the parties and recommended by this court, effective August 30, 2017.

On January 3, 2018, the parties filed a stipulation to modify the conditions of probation to eliminate the stated obligation of Respondent to comply with the conditions imposed in the underlying criminal matter. The basis for this request is the fact that there is no underlying criminal matter or resulting criminal probation.

Good cause appearing, the conditions of Respondent's probation is modified to eliminate the requirement that he comply with the "conditions of probation imposed in the underlying criminal matter."
