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On March 1, 2017, the Office of Chief Trial Counsel of the State Bar (OCTC) filed a Transmittal of Records of Conviction of Attorney stating that respondent has been convicted of violating Penal Code section 487, subdivision (a) (grand theft), a felony which involves moral turpitude. OCTC, however, attached insufficient evidence for this court to find that respondent has been so convicted, and we directed OCTC to file additional evidence to establish respondent's conviction.

On April 3, 2017, OCTC filed additional evidence, which we find establishes that respondent has been convicted of violating Penal Code section 487, subdivision (a) (grand theft), a felony which involves moral turpitude. Therefore, it is ordered pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 6102 that respondent be suspended from the practice of law effective May 8, 2017, pending final disposition of this proceeding. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 9.10(a).)

It is further ordered that respondent comply with California Rules of Court, rule 9.20, and perform the acts specified in subdivisions (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 days,



respectively, after the effective date of this suspension.


