On March 25, 2019, Respondent Timothy Elwood Gomes sought relief from the order assessing costs based on financial hardship and for an extension of time to take and pass the Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination (MPRE).

**1. Order Re Multistate Professional Responsibility Exam**

On April 3, 2019, the Office of Probation of the State Bar of California opposed Respondent's motion.

GOOD CAUSE APPEARING, Respondent's motion to extend time to take and pass the MPRE is **GRANTED**. Respondent is hereby **ORDERED** to provide proof of passage of the MPRE to the Office of Probation on or before **December 31, 2019**.

**2. Order Re Costs (S246283)**

On April 2, 2019, the Office of Chief Trial Counsel of the State Bar of California opposed a reduction of costs but did not oppose to an extension of time to pay costs.



Based on Respondent's financial hardship, the court hereby **GRANTS, in part,** Respondent's motion re disciplinary costs, and **ORDERS** that Respondent's time during which to pay the disciplinary costs be extended and **that one-fifth of the costs must be paid with his annual fees for each of the years 2020, 2021, 2022, 2023, and 2024.** If Timothy Elwood Gomes fails to pay any installment as described above, or as may be modified by the State Bar Court, the remaining balance is due and payable immediately. The payment of costs remains enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.

**IT IS SO ORDERED.**


