On March 15, 2019, Abraham A. Labbad (Respondent), filed a motion to extend time to take and pass the Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination (MPRE). By his motion, Respondent seeks an extension of time to submit proof of MPRE passage. Respondent states he has not taken the MPRE in 2018 or 2019, due to medical issues. On March 20, 2019, the Office of Chief Trial Counsel, by and through Senior Trial Counsel, Charles Calix, filed an opposition to Respondent's motion.

The court has carefully considered the pleadings and finds Respondent's request to take and provide proof of passage of the MPRE is consistent with protecting the public, the member's successful rehabilitation and, maintaining the integrity of the legal profession. (Rules Proc. of State Bar, rule 5.300(B).) As such, Respondent's motion is **GRANTED**. Respondent is to provide proof of passage of the MPRE to the Office of Probation on or before September 4, 2019 but if not provided by that date, Respondent will not be granted another extension without the appropriate documentation of his MPRE registration and, if appropriate, a declaration from a medical professional.
