In the Matter of KENNETH BRYAN BROCK, A Member of the State Bar, No. 158311.

Case No. 17-C-00154 ORDER

Since respondent Kenneth Bryan Brock, State Bar Number 158311, has been convicted of violating: Vehicle Code sections 23550-23152, subdivision (a) (driving under the influence [DUI] with prior DUI convictions) with an admitted misdemeanor enhancement of Vehicle Code section 23578, a felony; and Vehicle Code section 14601.2, subdivision (a) (driving when privilege suspended for prior DUI conviction), a misdemeanor, it is ordered pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 6102 that respondent be suspended from the practice of law effective April 17, 2017, pending final disposition of this proceeding. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 9.10(a).) It is also ordered that respondent comply with California Rules of Court, rule 9.20, and perform the acts specified in subdivisions (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 days, respectively, after the effective date of this suspension.

As the judgment of conviction is final, this case is referred to the Hearing Department under the authority of California Rules of Court, rule 9.10(a), for a hearing and decision recommending the discipline to be imposed in the event that the Hearing Department finds that



the facts and circumstances surrounding the misdemeanor violation of which respondent was convicted, involved moral turpitude or other misconduct warranting discipline.
