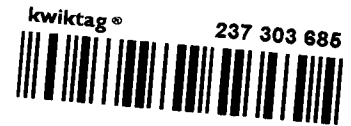

2. Date and court of conviction; offense(s).

The record of conviction reflects that the above-named member of the State Bar was convicted as follows:

Date of entry of conviction: January 25, 2018

Convicting court: United States District Court Southern District of Florida

Case number(s): 17-CR-20883

Crime(s) of which convicted and classification(s): Violation of Title 18 United States Code §371, Conspiracy to unlawfully sell unregistered securities, in violation of Title 15 United States Code §77e(a)(1), 77e(a)(2) and 77x, and Title 17 Code of Federal Regulations §230.144, one count, felony involving moral turpitude.

As to felony classification: Title 15 United States Code §77x provides for imprisonment for not more than five years. This is a class D felony pursuant to 18 United States Code §3559(a)(4).

As to moral turpitude classification: Elements of conspiracy are agreement to accomplish illegal objective and the intent to commit the underlying offense (*United States v. Moe* (2015) 781 F.3d 1120, 1124). Underlying offense, violation of Title 15 United States Code §77x, includes making an untrue statement of material fact or omitting a material fact necessary to not mislead (see Plea Agreement, para. 18). This deception/fraud constitutes moral turpitude (see *United States v. Lloyd* (2015) 807 F.3d 1128, 1176 [re Title 15 United States Code §77x] and *In re Utz* (1989) 48 Cal.3d 468, 484 [re fraud]).

3. Compliance with Rule 9.20. (Applicable only if checked.)

We bring to the Court's attention that, should the Court enter an order of interim suspension herein, the Court may wish to require the above-named member to comply with the provisions of rule 9.20, California Rules of Court, paragraph (a), within 30 days of the effective date of any such order; and to file the affidavit with the Clerk of the State Bar Court provided for in paragraph (c) of rule 9.20 within 40 days of the effective date of said order, showing the member's compliance with the provisions of rule 9.20.




