Respondent Erik J. Graeff,, State Bar Number 265862, has been convicted of violating Oregon Revised Statutes section 166.220, subsection (1)(b) [intentionally discharging a firearm, blowgun, bow and arrow, crossbow or explosive device within the city limits of any city or within a residential area within urban growth boundaries at or in the direction of any person, building, structure or vehicle within the range of the weapon], a felony which may or may not involve moral turpitude, and Oregon Revised Statutes section 163.195 [recklessly endangering another person], a misdemeanor which may or may not involve moral turpitude.

Based on respondent's felony conviction, it is ordered pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 6102 that respondent be suspended from the practice of law effective June 3, 2019, pending final disposition of this proceeding. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 9.10(a).) It is further ordered that respondent comply with California Rules of Court, rule 9.20, and perform the acts specified in subdivisions (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 days, respectively, after the effective date of this suspension.



OCTC is also ordered to submit evidence of finality or provide an update on finality within 120 days.


