On March 7, 2019, the Office of Chief Trial Counsel of the State Bar of California (OCTC) filed an application seeking an order to enroll Grace Charlotte Budka (Respondent) as an inactive attorney of the State Bar of California, pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 6007, subdivision (c)(1), and rule 5.215 et seq. of the Rules of Procedure of the State Bar.¹ On March 7, 2019, a copy of the application was properly served on Respondent by certified mail, return receipt requested, at her official State Bar attorney records address. OCTC did not request a hearing. (See Rules Proc. of State Bar, rule 5.218.) Respondent did not submit a response to the application.

Section 6007, subdivision (c)(1), authorizes the court to order an attorney's involuntary inactive enrollment upon a finding that: 1) the attorney has not complied with section 6002.1 (failing to maintain an address of record); and 2) the attorney cannot be located after reasonable investigation.

Finding that OCTC's application for involuntary inactive enrollment satisfies the requirements of section 6007, subdivision (c)(1), and rule 5.219, the application is **GRANTED**. Accordingly, the court orders that Respondent Grace Charlotte Budka be involuntarily enrolled as an inactive attorney of the State Bar of California (Bus. & Prof. Code, § 6007, subd. (c)(1)), effective upon the filing of this order (Rules Proc. of State Bar, rule 5.219).
